There’s no reaching your full potential without Jesus. But with him? Wow! Read John 15:5.



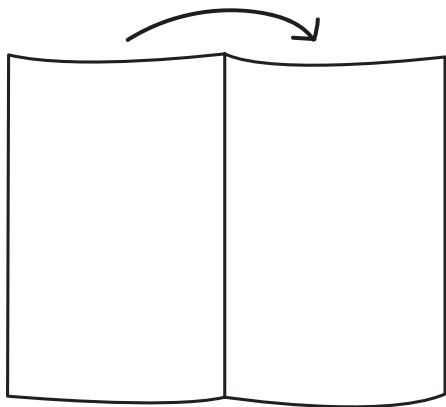
Make this page fly home!

Fold a flyer. When you get home

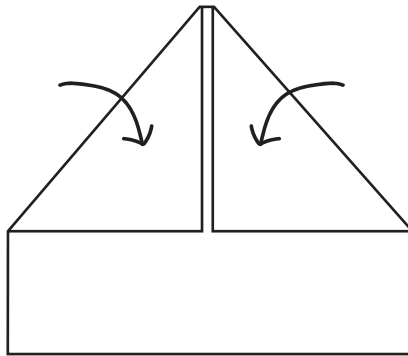
...find out how low can you go! See if you can fly under the radar by tossing this plane while lying on the floor.

Here's how:

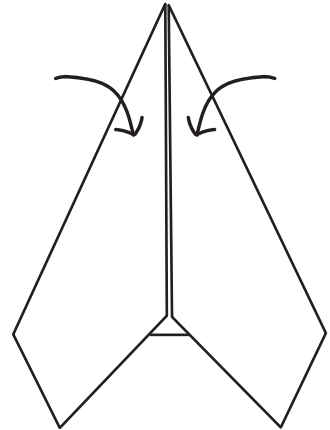
1 Fold the paper in half as shown.



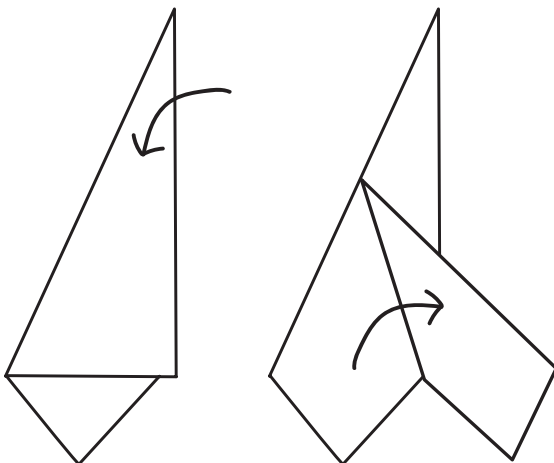
2 Unfold, and then fold the top two corners to the center line to create flaps.



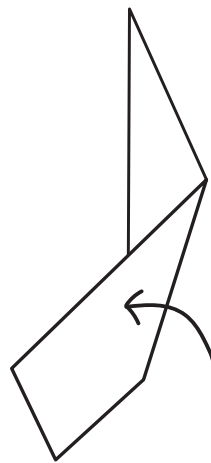
3 Fold each side to the center again.



4 Fold in half, then diagonally fold over the edge of the paper to make a wing.



5 Flip over and fold another wing to match the other side.



6 Grab the middle, and let it fly!
