5. YOUTH:

We invite all of our youth to join for a ZOOM on Sunday and Wednesday nights with Mrs. Lesa! Lesa is also meeting the youth through their phones each day for a Bible Study on the YOU version of the Bible. Our youth are participating in a Randolph-Macon opportunity via ZOOM on Sunday evenings. Ms. Lesa is visiting many of our youth (socially distant from others, of course!), as well!

6. STAFF:

We have moved to a Tuesday morning meeting on ZOOM! Our staff remains connected to both online updates that we have in the works, and we're working towards more and more use of technology to hold our positions in the best place that can serve God, our vision, mission, and YOU. Several staffers are adjusting their roles to fill the needs that "being remote" has created. Keep us in your prayers and continue to reach out!

7. FINANCES:

"Money, money," Well. It's what some of you say, and we're sensitive to the fact that many feel churches should **never** mention the word "money!" But, Jesus did. And so must we.

Financially, we were in a solid place when all of this started. Having funds hasn't always been the case for New Song: there were times in my first year when we had just \$2.76 in the checking account. I can't forget or unsee those days. Where we are now is this: **we are aiming to do <u>more</u> with <u>less</u>**. That's not new to the Coronavirus, but COVID-19 has been a HUGE reminder that every cent is precious in God's sight. We are being extra careful with your entrusted stewardship over Church expenses and accounts:

- All HVAC settings have been set to reflect a (primarily) empty building
- Our staff and leaders remain under a spending hold for now
- For ministries that have purchased items for events which have been canceled, we have returned those items at this time
- We have transitioned as many of our mailing needs to digital platforms as possible to reduce postage
- We have delayed all major purchasing to the fall
- We have continued to creatively suspend normal operating expenses
- We have clearly reduced our electric/power bills(!)
- It's not just about reducing expenses, it's also about teaching generosity, practicing social responsibility and helping those with a variety of needs (see below in point #10 for how you can help).
- YOU can be a BIG part of what GOD is doing right in our midst: as hardships, problems, concerns and reports continue to come in every day of reduced hours, lost jobs, layoffs, etc. requests for specific assistance will undoubtedly be pouring in as we're asked to *do even <u>more</u> with even <u>less</u>*. Wave to us when you walk by (and don't spin gravel in our parking lot: the Lord calls us all to extend grace, but our Trustees anticipate vandals will need to plead for mercy from a judge!).

We were able to collect a great deal of items for local food pantries and the Backpack Ministry: THANK YOU so much to all who participated!

The **Backpack Ministry** has continued as a direct result of a great relationship Alan Fearnow has cultivated within church partnerships and local school administrations. A tremendous THANK YOU goes to Alan and the Backpack Ministry Team for this vital ministry and to the schools who are allowing us to provide this ministry!

We have fielded several questions about our **SOLES4SOULS** Shoe Collection... see below, but thank you to the many who have brought in so many pairs of shoes! We are collecting any size, in gently-used condition, men's, women's or children's shoes.

Our **Counseling Ministry** is led by Heather Shaheen and Kimbely Williams. Both counselors continue to serve an increasing load of clients by E-sessions and phone. (So grateful for these skilled services our Church can continue to make available to some of our most vulnerable.)

And speaking of our most vulnerable: New Song has continued to run **errands** and collect **groceries** and **prescriptions** for those who either **can't** get out (or **shouldn't** get out). If you have needs that we can help support in some way, please do not hesitate to contact us at:

I'll end by making you aware of a new effort we're doing called **HEARTS, HANDS & FEET SUNDAY**, April 5. The Bible calls us to be salt & light, to be the hands & feet of Christ... and now we're asking you to put all of these together. As we work to serve our community, you are being invited to help with:

- + A Drive-Thru Gift Card Drive: (anything that can help others in their time of need: gas, food, Walmart, etc.)
- + Soles4Souls Shoe Drive: remember any sized pair of shoes in gently-used condition, adult or child
- + **KIDS** Packet Pick-up: we have a special treat for Kids just ahead of **Easter** PARENTS: come on by and pick up a craft, lesson and a food item just for the KIDS!
- + Non-perishable food items: all items will again be collected & go to the Food Banks & Backpack Ministry

Come on by – no need to get out of your car!

We'll have bins for each item – pick-ups and drop-offs accepted between **3-5pm** on Palm Sunday, April 5.
