

Memo: Coronavirus, Update #6 March 26, 2020

From the Desk of Pastor Chad

Greetings, New Song Family!

I miss you guys! I can't help it! I'm praying hard for each of you.

As of noon today, we have heard from our Bishop that United Methodist Churches will remain closed for in-person worship in accordance with the Governor's protocols laid out in his recent press briefing.

- 1. Live Stream, through 4/26
- 2. **Sunrise**, LiveStream, 6:30am
- 3. Easter cancellations
- 4. Good Friday
- 5. **Communion**
- 6. Hearts, Hands & Feet Sunday
- 7. Contact, Giving & Resources
- 8. Psalm 116:1-2

What does this mean for New Song?

We will continue to hold online/livestreaming services through the **end of April**. The decision to proceed with in-person worship will be re-evaluated before May 3; we will communicate a clear plan for moving forward in light of any changes at that time as it pertains to re-entry.

But what about Easter?

Unfortunately, in-person worship services will not be a possibility. The medical community in charge of keeping us as safe as possible concludes that a rushed timetable on in-person worship will mean dramatic increases in COVID-19 cases and exposure to not only community spread and symptoms, but, also, increased rates of hospitalization or worse. After review of all available directives, the choice to proceed towards May 3 is clear.

Easter will be a very different day for us... Hollywood Cemetery has asked that we not bring hundreds of people to their location for **Sunrise Services**, so we will be streaming that service. I am serving as this year's preacher for that time in worship, so I do hope you will tune in at **6:30am on Easter Sunday** to our service.

Secondly, this change also shifts our 9 & 10:30am in-person services to one, Livestream service at 10:00am.

Thirdly, we have had to cancel many of our Easter special events... our April 4th Eggstravaganza and PEEP Show have been tucked away for this year. For more information, check our website out for additional details: www.newsongumc.org/events

Fourthly, our **Good Friday** service will take place via **LiveStream at 7pm** on April 10.

Fifthly, we are planning Communion to occur when we can all be back in place. Everyone has had such creative ideas for worship and different elements; however, our tradition remains very focused on having Communion together and in-person. We will honor Communion in ways that keep us "legal" within our denomination – but in the meantime, we invite you to be mindful of Christ's presence with us in all times and spaces, especially now.

Lastly, we'd like to put materials in the hands of KIDS & FAMILIES!

On **Palm Sunday, from 3-5pm**, I invite you to join us for an afternoon of being Christ's presence in the form of **HEARTS (Ministry), HANDS (Palms) & FEET (Shoes) SUNDAY!** The Bible calls us to be salt & light, to be the hands & feet of Christ... and now we're asking you to put all of these together. **Help us help our Community**:

- + A Drive-Thru Gift Card Drive: (anything that can help others in their time of need: gas, food, Walmart, etc.)
- + Soles4Souls Shoe Drive: remember any sized pair of shoes in gently-used condition, adult or child
- + **KIDS** Packet Pick-up: we have a special treat for Kids just ahead of **Easter** PARENTS: come on by and pick up a craft, lesson and a food item just for the KIDS!
- + Non-perishable food items: all items will again be collected & go to the Food Banks & Backpack Ministry

Come on by – <u>no need</u> to get out of your car! We'll have bins for each item – pick-ups and drop-offs accepted between **3-5pm** on Palm Sunday, April 5.
